## Food Pantry

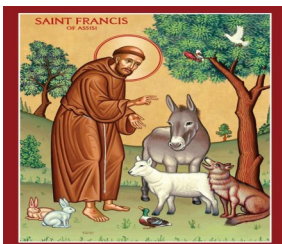

Do you have the time to pray?

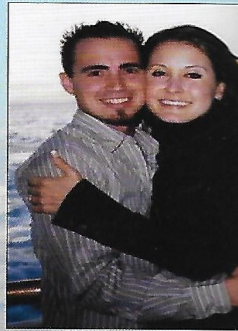
Overwhelmed and frantic

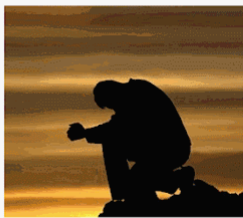
