Delegates are needed to attend this meeting for voting purposes. The meeting is June 13th & 14th. If interested, see Pastor Tim.

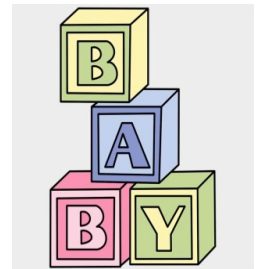
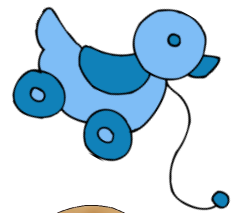
New Church Service Hours for Summer

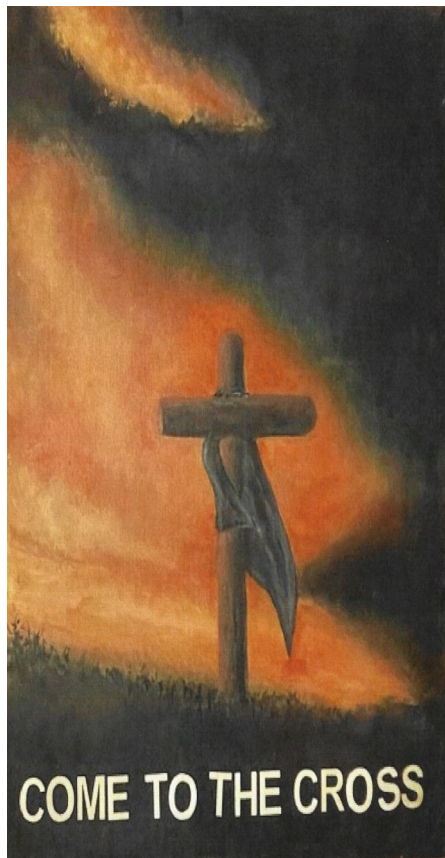

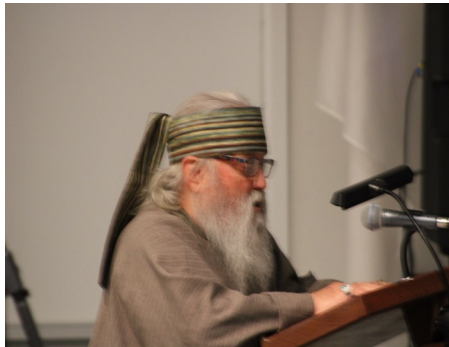

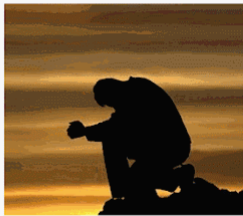
