One adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging*

One sturdy comb, remove packaging

One metal nail clippers (with or without attached file), remove packaging

***Toothbrush multi-packs may be used by sealing an individual toothbrush**

in a business-size envelope; no plastic bags or wrap.
